What is Required?

The Illinois General Assembly passed the Livestock Management Facilities Act (LMFA) on May 21, 1996. Since that law was enacted, livestock facilities in Illinois that house over 300 animal units (for example, 750 finishing hogs, 214 dairy cows, or 300 beef cattle) are required to have at least one person certified in the environmental protection aspects of manure management. The "Certified Livestock Manager" is expected to be a full-time employee who is familiar with the manure management system of the farm, located within one-hour driving distance to the farm, and accessible by phone when needed. Young family members (<18 years old) are welcome to take the training, but they cannot be the only certified manager at their facilities.

To become a certified livestock manager:

- 300-999 animal units: attend a workshop or complete online training
- ≥1,000 animal units: attend a workshop and pass IDoA's paper-based test offered immediately following each workshop OR complete online training and pass online test (in lieu of the IDoA's paper-based test).

Upon successful completion of these requirements, producers are **certified for three years**.

Workshop Information

Workshop sign-in starts at 8:30. The training will begin promptly at 9:00 am. Please allow 3.5 hours for the workshop and additional time to complete the IDOA test if needed.

Snacks will be provided. U of I Extension's training fee is \$40 and IDoA's certification fee is \$30 (total \$70).

CLM Test

The CLM test was updated last year. Now, there are 50 questions on both paper-based and online test. The pass rate is the same, 70% (35 questions). A Spanish version of the test is also available.

Can't attend a workshop?

Our updated online training is available at go.illinois.edu/CLMT. This new version of online training follows the same format as in-person workshops. There are nine modules (10-20 min videos), and you can work through these modules at your own pace. If you have more than 1,000 animal units, you can take the test online at the end of the training. You are allowed multiple attempts on the test. Each time you take the test, 50 questions will be randomly selected from our question bank. The online training fee is \$40 (plus \$30 certification fee, total \$70).
