**D. Supporting Justification and Verification Documents:**

Pursuant to 8 Ill. Adm. Code 900.506 (a), the owner or operator of a livestock management facility or livestock waste handling facility shall provide the Department with copies of verification documents upon completion of construction. Such verification documents shall include:

- Photographic records of excavation and site preparation including any soil compaction, footing preparation and construction, concrete forming including steel reinforcement, construction joints during construction, walls and floors after form removal, installation of perimeter drains if needed, and any other items deemed necessary by the owner or operator, engineer, or construction personnel.  
--For structures constructed of concrete, a signed statement from the concrete supplier indicating the quality of the concrete.

Failure to provide such information may delay or impede the Department's final issuance of a certification of construction completeness.

**E. Structures Constructed with Design Standards used by the Natural Resources Conservation Service of the United States Department of Agriculture:**

In the case of structures constructed with the design standards used by the Natural Resources Conservation Service of the United States Department of Agriculture, copies of the design standards used and a statement of verification signed by a representative of the United States Department of Agriculture must accompany the owner's or operator's certification of compliance.

**F. Filing Fee:**

Pursuant to 510 ILCS 77/13 (f), a \$250 filing fee must accompany this certification of compliance.

**G. Inspection:**

The Department will inspect the construction site within 10 business days following receipt of this certification of compliance to determine compliance with the construction standards of the Livestock Management Facilities Act. Within 5 business days of the date of inspection, the Department will send an official written notice to the owner or operator of the livestock waste handling facility indicating that the facility meets the standards or identifying the remedial measures necessary to enable the facility to meet the standards.

**H. Certification Statement:**

**“I hereby certify that the information provided on this form is correct and that the livestock waste handling facility has been constructed to meet or exceed the standards as required by the Livestock Management Facilities Act (510 ILCS 77/1 et seq.). Furthermore, I certify that the information included on the originally submitted registration form, any subsequently submitted amendments, and any information attached to this form is correct.”**
