Applications are reviewed by the Panel for topic category, inclusion of proper information and conformity to IPERC goals and objectives. Interviews, if necessary, will be conducted before a formal recommendation is presented to all members of IPERC. Additional interview may be requested by the full membership of IPERC before a decision is made. Applicants will be notified of IPERC's decision on the Application in a timely manner.

Applications can be obtained and completed at any time during the year. Completed applications must be submitted to the Member Grants Panel 30 days in advance of the IPERC quarterly meeting, for the application to be presented to the full membership of IPERC.

Statement of the Project

This project is a continuation of the 2020 Commercial Lawn Mower Incentive program; however, we have added Propane Vehicles. Rebates are available to propane customers who reside in Illinois for eligible purchases on New Propane vehicle, New vehicle conversions, New propane powered Lawn Mowers, or conversions of gas Lawn mowers to Propane.

What vehicles are eligible?

- New OEM Propane vehicles
- New Propane conversion vehicles (current model year or previous model with less than 15,000 miles)
- New Propane OEM Lawn Mower or converted to Propane prior to first use
- Lawn Mower converted to Propane with less than 250 hours

All Propane Vehicles & Mowers and conversions systems MUST be approved by US EPA or CARB certified.

Applicants will mail or email all required paperwork and documentation to the Illinois Propane Gas Association (IPGA). The reimbursement will only be paid to the applicant. Dealers will be supplied with marketing tools for local promotion.

The reimbursement is available for the 2021 program and will allow for Propane vehicles and commercial lawn care professionals, landscape companies, golf courses, cities, universities, etc. to be reimbursed for multiple propane powered vehicles or lawn mowers per year (up to three \$1,000 rebates for New OEM Propane Vehicles or OEM Propane Lawn Mowers & New converted mowers) or actual cost up to \$750 rebate for conversions of older vehicles with less than 15,000 miles or lawn mowers with less than 250 hours or combination of new and conversions totaling \$3,000 per company per year) which presents an attractive situation for a commercial company to go with a propane fueled lawn mower. Ultimately, the goal of this program is to promote propane as a safe "green fuel".

This grant is on a first come first served basis and will close once all funds have been depleted.

This program will be administered by the IPGA.
