Illinois Department of Agriculture in cooperation with the US Forest Service's Slow the Spread Program have proposed treatment areas for spraying to control the Spongy Moth. Depending on weather, Splat GM-Organic Mating Disruptor, will be sprayed from yellow air tractors the week of June 16th
