
Btk Aerial Application for Spongy Moths 2,449 Acres - 2 applications May 2024 1st Draft





Proposed Treatments



This area to be treated for an infestation of the Spongy moth with Btk -Bacillus thuringiensis var. Kurstaki. Btk is a bacterial insecticide that occurs naturally, It is cultured by fementing grains. Foray 48B Organic is the product used. The area will be treated mid May 2024, weather permitting, then a 2nd application in 7-10 days The Btk will be sprayed from low flying helicoptors. Red area is the area to be sprayed, Green outline is flight only. This program is managed by the Illinois Department of Agriculture and the Slow the Spread Foundation.
