THE 2025 NH<sub>3</sub> SAFETY SCHOOLS are offered through the combined efforts of IFCA and the Illinois Department of Agriculture. IFCA and IDA prepare the content of the course and instructors cover topics and issues related to NH<sub>3</sub> safety.

Anhydrous ammonia is an extremely hazardous material. Experience in Illinois has shown that NH<sub>3</sub> can be handled and used safely. IFCA's annual NH<sub>3</sub> safety schools have contributed to this good safety record for over 40 years.

\*Training is mandatory once every three years by State and Federal Law.
