Program Overview

Illinois Department of Agriculture (IDOA) is implementing its inaugural Operationalizing Vital Ecosystem Resilience (I-COVER) Program. The program promotes the implementation of cover crops and the adoption of no-till cover via the Partners for Conservation (PFC) Program using the USDA Conservation Service (USDA-NRCS) Regional Conservation Partnership Program (RCPP) multi-state grant. The I-COVER Program includes a multi-state partnership between Illinois, Indiana, and Iowa.

Program Application

Users will be able to enter their information into the [I-COVER Program application](#) and validate it during a pre-enrollment period starting at 8 a.m. on Monday, February 10, 2025. Applications can be submitted once the program opens at 8 a.m. on Monday, March 3, 2025. Once available, applications can be saved at any time, prior to submittal, and must be completed in full prior to the program closing at 11:59 p.m. on Friday, March 14, 2025, to be eligible.

Application requirements include contact information; farm, tract, field, and common land unit (CLU) numbers; and field acres seeded to cover crops in late summer or fall 2025, 2026, and 2027. Selected applicants must also provide a CCC-902, FSA Subsidiary Report and a Producer Farm Data Report or proof of control of land.

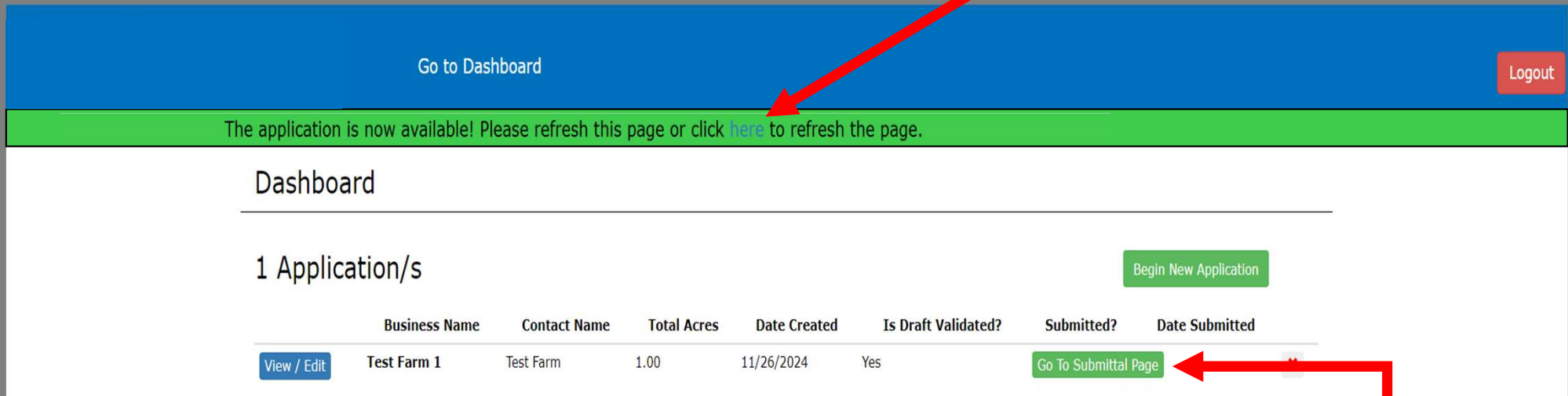
